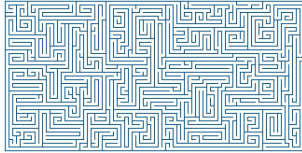


Who Let the Gods Out

Curriculum project homework ideas – be as creative as you like. Have fun!

Once you have completed your homework, take a photo and upload it to Class Dojo.

Design and make your own Labyrinth. Listen to the story of Theseus and the Minotaur and then design your own maze. <https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/ks2-primary-history-ancient-greece-theseus/zkvqkmm> It could be made of straws, string or wood.



Create a picture of an imaginary Greek God. Make sure your poster is eye-catching and full of facts and information. Try to think of a symbol for your God.



Write an advert persuading people to visit the ancient Olympic Games. Research the games, you could look at what events took place in the very first games and encourage people to join in.



Who was Pythagoras? How is he linked to maths? What is Pythagoras' theory? Present your findings – use diagrams to explain what you have learnt.



Cook some Greek food or a meal. Research what foods Greece is famous for, and look up some recipes for a traditional Greek dish. You can write up the recipes to show us and upload a photo of your creation to class dojo.



Find out some simple Greek phrases. E.g Hello, How are you? What's your name? etc. Can you make a poster to display them in Greek and English? If you can learn the pronunciation, can you try and teach us at school?
