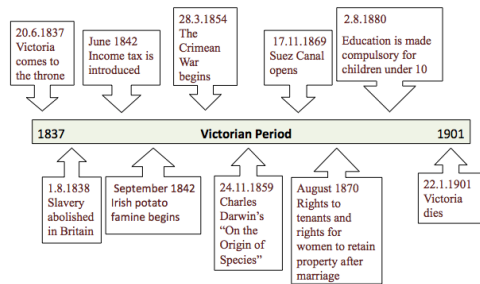


Children of the Revolution

Create a timeline of the Victorian era. When did it start and end? What major events happened? You could make a visual timeline, a written timeline or a mix of both.



Research the ingredients of a Victoria sponge and bake one!



Write a diary entry as a child in the Victorian era. You could be a rich child and have spent your day in school, or you could be a poor child and have spent your day in the workhouse.



Research one of the inventions created during the Industrial Revolution. Create an information page with written information and diagrams about your chosen invention.



Compare a rich and a poor person living in the Victorian era. You could draw them and show a comparison in what they are wearing, look at the types of jobs they may have had or the types of houses they may have lived in etc.



Create a poster about being safe on the internet. Think about how you will make your poster eye-catching and think about the important information you should include.
