Create a time capsule containing artefacts from the past to bring in and share with the class.



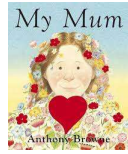
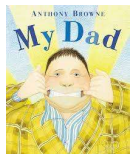
Paint, Sketch or Collage - Look at portraits of children from the past and create a portrait of themselves in the same style.
