

Around the world

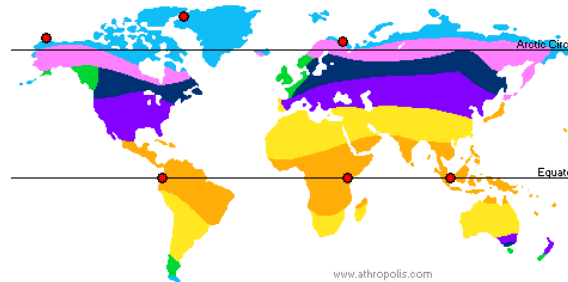
Our school expectation is that children will complete **ONE** of these activities **by the end of the half term** – though they may do more if they wish.
