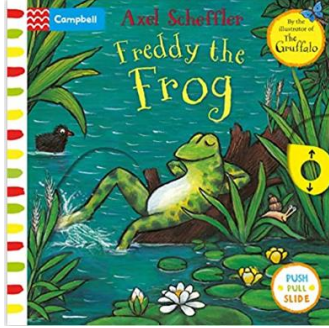


## A child of our times
